



Michigan Youth Leadership Training

Staff Job Descriptions

Application Deadline: June 1st, 2015

The Michigan Youth Leadership Training (MIYLT) will be held July 26-31, 2015 at Camp Tuhsmeheeta in Greenville, MI with the focus on social justice, leadership, service, cultural diversity, and friendship. During this week, you will discover themselves through creating new friendships, self-discovery, adventures, leadership-building and service. The staff at MIYLT is essential to creating this powerful, lasting, and life-changing experience for the youth participants.

The following are the available staff positions at MIYLT:

Job Description: Primary Group Leader

Primary Group Leaders are senior staff at MIYLT, fill by experienced youth workers. Primary Group Leaders are responsible for leading a diverse group of 8-10 high school students with the assistance of an Assistant Group Leader(s). This includes intensive, experiential wilderness activities, intellectually stimulating seminars, cultural exchanges, off-site service projects and reflection. Primary Group Leaders are responsible for overseeing their assigned Assistant Group Leader(s) and cultivating a positive working relationship with them.

Primary Group Leaders must be 18 years of age or older and will earn \$250 for the week.

Job Description: Assistant Group Leader

Assistant Group Leaders take an essential role at MIYLT by always being with the Primary Group and assisting their Primary Group Leader with his/her needs/responsibilities. The Assistant Group Leader helps lead leadership activities, reflections, off-site service projects, along with seminars and trainings. Assistant Group Leaders are responsible for cultivating positive work relationships with the Primary Group Leaders and the campers.

Assistant Group Leaders must be 16 years of age or older and will earn \$100 for the week.

Job Description: Resource Staff

Resource Staff are crucial elements at MIYLT. Resource Staff make sure everything is running smoothly for the activities to take place. Resource Staff set up and cleanup activities, seminars, and trainings. Resource Staff help run the simulations, trainings, and off-site service projects that the youth participants take part in throughout the week. Some Resource Staff will help train youth participants Mentors. Resource Staff make sure the environment of camp is comfortable, safe, efficient, and fun!

Resource Staff must have attended or worked camp before and will earn \$100 for the week.

Staff Training will take place on July 23 – 26, 2015 and Staff Debrief on July 31, 2015

All staff will participate in a thorough MIYLT training and orientation covering service-learning, social justice, team building and full MIYLT program overview. All staff live, work on-site, and sleep in the cabins with you participants during the entire week of camp. All staff will participate in the staff debrief.
